

Scarecrow, Cat and Sunflower October Plate

This is a companion piece to the one done in 2005. If you are new and want the instructions for the 2005 piece let me know and I will bring both to the meeting. These are easy, tedious, but easy.

Supplies:

12" flat scalloped wood plate, (PL-667, \$18.25 at Unique Woods),

2, 6, 8 flats, 3/8 angle brush and a very fine liner.

A dab of Extender if you have it, and a scruffy brush for cheeks.

PREP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Base plate SP
2. Base face, hands and top of legs NF. Shade all edges except neck edge with RIO. Same color, (NF) for top of cat's tail, right rear rump and right side of face. Shade all edges RIO.
3. Base hat and lower legs, (the shoes,) AG, shade BU.
4. Base hair HB, shade under hat and outline with thin line of BU.
5. Base outer petals of Sunflowers with GS. Hit/miss thin outline of petal with AG. Base middle ring of sunflowers AG, using a hit/miss thin line of BU to outline both sides of center ring of AG.
6. Centers of sunflowers are checkerboards of BU and BS. (Magnifying glass useful.)
7. Base Leaves HGL. Stems, center line in leaves and hit/miss leaf outlines are HGM. Horizontal grass line is HGM, vertical grass lines are HGL. Base pumpkin stem in HGM. When dry add three vertical lines of HGL.
8. Base pumpkin P.
9. Dress collar is BS. When dry add stitch lines I forgot in P. Dress is BP. When dry add stitch lines I forgot in BO.
10. Base rest of cat in CG. (Mixing a grey changes the grayed brown tones needed to make this work, just as changing the SP plate color removes that touch of grey needed to make cat look like it belongs in the color scheme.) Base cat nose and mouth, (mouth is the two lower lines,) in RIO.
